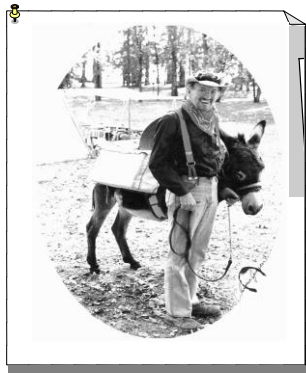

Hours are 10am--5pm. Entrance prices are: Adults - \$8. Seniors -\$7. Children -\$6. Vets -\$5.

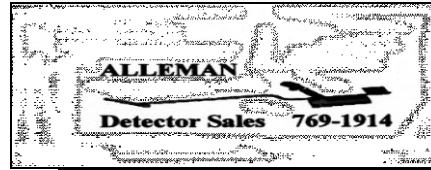
